Can I participate if I have never driven on a racetrack before?

Absolutely, this event is for everybody. This is your chance to do something you have never done before. You might even pick up some driving tips that will help you in your day to day driving! We will walk you through everything you will need to know before you start.

Do I have to drive by myself or can I bring company along?

If you have some friends or family that would like to do this with you, bring them along. There is a four person max per entry.

Is the registration fee per car or per person?

The entry fee is for the vehicle! So share the driving with family or friends and split the cost! Up to 4 people per entry allowed.

How many people can be in one car?

We have a maximum of four per team.

Can I bring my 10 year old son?

Yes, your children are welcome to come with you, but you must sign and submit the Minor Waiver form; it can be found on our web site. They will not be allowed in hazardous areas and will be required to be under a guardian's or your supervision at all times. Obviously, no one under 16 years of age will be allowed to drive on or off track.

What if I get in an accident?

While driving on public roads, you are responsible for any and all accidents, just as if you were going to the grocery store, or out to dinner. For your own safety, we expect you to obey all traffic laws and speed limits; we will not ask nor expect you to do anything that puts you at undue risk. We ask for proof of insurance to ensure you do have adequate insurance just in case such an incident should happen.

There will be first aid and ambulatory services available at each track in the unlikely event of an on-track accident.

What if my car gets damaged?

If you are on the public highway, you would use your personal insurance. Highway sections are just like any trip you make in your vehicle. There is no additional protection or insurance implied or offered from any organizer, sponsor, or staff.

Should an unlikely incident happen while driving on track, you are responsible for the damage to your vehicle. It is your responsibility to figure out if your personal insurance will cover such events as this. There is no additional protection, or insurance implied or offered from any organizer, sponsor, or staff.

How will I know where to go once we start?

Once registered you will be sent a welcome kit, this kit will contain everything you need to know. We will also post updates and information on our web site; follow the forum for ongoing information.

What happens if I get a traffic violation?

Its all yours... While driving on public roads, you are responsible for any and all traffic violations, just as if you were going to the grocery store, or out to dinner. For your own safety, we expect you to obey all traffic laws and speed limits; we will not ask nor expect you to do anything that puts you at undue risk.

Do I have to race on all the tracks or can I only do one or two of them?

Do you accept payment on a credit card?

Can I register on the day of the event?

We have a limited number of spots, so there is a good chance you will not be able to participate if you wait until the weekend of the event to register. However, if spots are still available at the kick-off, we will accept registration.

My racing club wants to come as a group. Do you give any kind of discount if there are a lot of us?

If you are part of a car group and want to enter seven or more vehicles, please contact us via email or phone.

I don't want to race but am interested in volunteering. Who should I contact?
